Complete an application form and undergo a financial assessment.

If your loan is successful, Habitat builders will assess your property needs.

You will make two initial repayments and then Habitat will undertake the necessary work.

Continue zero interest payments to Habitat for loan period.

All works large and small are considered, although cost is generally capped at \$20,000. Please do contact us to tell us your needs, as each application is considered on its own merits.
